TRANSITIONAL ITEM:

Finding: The increase in class size has placed strains on infrastructure and some resources for the educational programs. Concerns were raised by students that the patient volume at the VA Medical Center was insufficient due to the increasing number of learners. Students noted that study space was inadequate or marginal in some facilities

The fourth year required internal medicine rotation at the VA hospital recently underwent a change in course directorship. With this change students have had increased autonomy to work-up patients in a similar manner as a first year resident. This increased responsibility has led to a more robust clinical experience for students. The patient volume at the VA is cyclical and the student concerns may have been voiced during a time when the volume was decreased. The patient volume at the VA will be evaluated on the end of the year evaluations in July 2012 for continued concerns.

The fourth year subcommittee has met several times and is in the process of finalizing a proposal to the curriculum committee to revamp the fourth year offerings to make them more suitable for students' career choices. Students will have the choice of doing a sub-internship in internal medicine, pediatrics, obstetrics-gynecology etc. as opposed to all students being mandated to do an internal medicine rotation. This will automatically decrease the number of student learners at all sites, allowing for more patient interaction.

In addition, the Interim Dean has decreased the enrollment for the upcoming class to 68 from 75 in response to these concerns.

In regards to study space, we immediately reconfigured furniture in the Year 2 space in the Erma Ora Byrd building to accommodate an additional 28 students. This area was a focal point because both year one and two students use this facility as a primary study area. As soon as the additional spaces were created students provided immediate feedback indicating approval and gratitude.

In addition, an additional 12 study spaces were created for our third and fourth year students in the Medical Education Center building very near our Health Science Library which is the primary study venue for these students.

We will continue to monitor end of year evaluations as well as anecdotal feedback on the appropriateness and availability of study space for our students.
